Notes for UBC Applicants

Requirements for Admission under the agreement

To be eligible for admission, an applicant must have successfully completed the JD First Year Curriculum at UBC and 30 UBC credits of upper level courses including all required courses for completion the JD degree with a cumulative grade average of at least 74%.

Application Deadline and required supporting documents

The completed application form together with the following supporting documents should be returned to the Faculty of Law, 10/F, Cheng Yu Tung Tower, Centennial Campus, The University of Hong Kong, Pokfulam Road, Pokfulam, Hong Kong by January 31, 2019:

- Academic transcript #
- A personal statement *
- Academic references

You are advised to provide us with all official academic transcripts for each post-secondary institution that you have attended and are currently attending.

* An essay of no more than 750 words about yourself, outlining why you consider yourself suitable for selection to the programme, and why you wish to apply for the programme.
